New Art Exhibits Open at Tubac Center of the Arts

February 15, 2022, Tubac, AZ. Tubac Center of the Arts, (TCA) announces the opening of three new art exhibitions on Friday, February 25, 2022, with an opening reception, 5-7pm. The reception is open to the public and admission to the center is always free.

“Shock of the New West” is a national juried art exhibition presenting 55 works of art juried by artist [William Martin](#) of Tucson. The artists have created works that put a contemporary spin on a western theme.

“Donde Mueren los Sueños/Where Dreams Die” is a group exhibition of artwork focusing on the human side of border and immigration issues. The annual **“Open Studio Tour Artists’ Exhibit”** presents the work of participating studio tour artists. The free self-guided tour is held on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, March 11, 12, and 13, 2022. Sixty-two artists throughout the Santa Cruz Valley from Green Valley to Rio Rico will open their homes and studios for an opportunity for visitors to meet and purchase artwork directly from the artists. Over 20 galleries in Tubac will also be open on Friday evening, March 11, from 4pm-7pm. Visitors to the galleries that evening have an opportunity to enjoy refreshments and win raffle prizes.
